The 2016 Wheelchairs Handover Ceremony to APHT The Volunteers Group to Send Wheelchairs to Overseas Children Japan in Cooperation with Association of the Physically Handicapped of Thailand

The Volunteers Group to Send Wheelchairs to Overseas Children Japan, with cooperation of Association of the Physically Handicapped of Thailand and Thai with Disability Foundation, donated 90 wheelchairs to children with physical disabilities and mobility impairment who study in special education schools in rural areas. The objective of this project is to provide wheelchairs to students living in remote areas where there is shortage of wheelchairs and orthotics & prosthetics. Given the wheelchairs, children with disabilities can move more freely, leading to more independent lives. As a result, their quality of life will be improved in term of education as well as their daily life.

The Wheelchair Handover Ceremony of the Year 2016 shall be organized on June 29, 2016 at Nakhon Inn 1 Room, the Rich Hotel, Praram 5 Road, Nontaburi Province. There will be 100 honorable guests consisting of representatives from The Volunteers Group to Send Wheelchairs to Overseas Children Japan, directors, teachers and students with physical disabilities and mobility impairments and disability leaders.

The wheelchairs shall be handed to 5 schools and special education centers:

1. Srisangwan Chiang Mai School
2. Regional Special Education Center 1, Nakhon Pathom
3. Nonthaburi Special Education Center
4. Udon Thani Special Education Center
5. Saraburi Special Education Center



Message of Mr.Hirokazu Morita, president of Japanese NGO

Mr.Suppacheep Didthad, president of APHT and all APHT staff who are making contribution to support children with disabilities in Thailand.

We would like to appreciate your collaboration of arranging handing over ceremony of 90 wheelchairs to needy children in Thailand.

Mr. T. Kimura, who is our local representative in Thailand, takes part of the function this time on our behalf.

On this occasion, 90 wheelchairs will be donated to needy children with disability of 5 Special Education Centers in Thailand as our forth donation to your Association of Physically Handicapped Thailand. Now total number of wheelchairs donated by us to you is 330 unites.

Japanese children wheelchairs are designed for children with disability mainly caused by cerebral palsy and brain trouble as a medical equipment and personally made according to children's condition, so those are very expensive almostUS\$2.000 per unit. In Japan, however, the government subsidizes 90 % of cost to parents of children under social welfare scheme. Wheelchairs become smaller as children grow and replaced to the other one to fit in 3-4 year time. The old ones have been wasted.

Thus our NGO collects the wheelchairs which Japanese parents donate and refurbish them in good condition for safety and durability. We provided 5281wheelchairs as free donation to needy children in 22 countries.

Those wheelchairs will assist Children with disability to go to school and clinics as well as working places, keeping muscle and bones in right position to improve physical and spiritual health condition. Parents will be able to leave children safely at home to join in social and economic activities. With this project, children with disability can easily move to exchange with people of community to socialize with environment. It will raise the solidarity and awareness of the community to children and their family. Community is obliged to respect the right and dignity of children with disability and to give the opportunity to fulfill their potential on an equal basis.

Therefore, wheelchair is very essential and effective tool for development of community as well as physical, educational and vocational rehabilitation.

We understand that wheelchairs are rented to parents of children and maintained in good condition to check air of tires, break, wheels and etc. When wheelchairs will be smaller, those are taken to next children needed wheelchairs. So parents have social responsibility to take a good care of wheelchairs for next beneficiaries.

In order to make our project sustainable, your careful attention to maintain wheelchair in good condition and to keep beneficiaries list up to dated very much appreciated.

It is our sincere wish that our project will make a positive contribution to the children of Thailand and their community, making another milestone in promoting further friendly relations between Thailand and Japan.
